You don't have to board that famous old Choo Choo to get to Chattanooga, Tennessee, for next year's Paper Doll Convention. beautiful Tennessee River is overlooked by a wonderfully designed recreation area that includes an art museum, a fantastic aquarium and an arts district with interesting galleries and little restaurants.


An unusual museum houses one eccentric woman's amazing collection of glass, and there will be an organized tour of that attraction on Wednesday before the convention officially kicks off.


