This index consists of 4 parts:

- 1.) A Table that lists all Issues in descending order including:

 - Year of Publication (and the month or season if known)
 - Theme of the Issue
 - Themed articles (including title and author) and Dress-A-Doll artist
 - Featured Artist (when there is one)
- 2.) A Listing by Subject of Other Articles Unrelated to the Issue's Theme
- 3.) A Listing of all Themes alphabetically with Subject Headings
- 4.) A List of Featured Columns that regularly appear
